The Organization for the Promotion of International Relations (OPIR) Kyoto University, Graduate School Energy Science (ES), Research Institute for Sustainable Humanosphere (RISH), Global Center for Education and Research on Human Security Engineering (HSE), Center for Southeast Asian Studies (CSEAS) are co-hosting the 3rd SUSTAIN (International Conference on a Sustainable Future for Human Security) 2012 which is organised by the Indonesian Student Association (ISA) Kyoto, Japan.

The past two conferences have attracted more than 250 participants from Europe, Africa and Asia, with highly-qualified papers and posters. This time we are expecting more than two hundred participants for oral and poster presentations. The SUSTAIN conference originated from the need to provide an inter-disciplinary forum where the most serious problems affecting a sustainable future for human security can be discussed, in recognition of the fact that many future problems cannot be solved by a "siloeed" approach.

The Sustainable Future for Human Security also includes the following objectives :

- To provide a forum for international researchers community to discuss, share and exchange their latest research progress in relation with sustainable future issues.
- To develop and promote a sustainable networking between participants to hold human securities and bridging ideas into policies and desired realities.
- To broaden information access for scientific communities toward global scientific, technology, social, economics and engineering societies
- To empower Asian in general and South East Asia in particular for research collaboration, network and partnership among researcher communities and decision makers.

The scope of SUSTAIN 2012 encompasses but is not limited to:

1. Energy and Environment (EnE)
2. Sustainable Agriculture (A)
3. Sustainable Built Environment in Tropical Hemisphere Countries (BE)
4. Environmental Friendly and Efficient Technology (FT)
5. Hydrology and Disaster Prevention (HnD)
6. Social Science (S)
